EASY REGISTRATION PROCESS

Attach your paper to the registration form and return both to your high schools or community representative no later than Friday, February 19, 2010. Compose a paper which states your opinion on one of the following topics: (1) "Why I choose not to use alcohol and other drugs", or (2) "What can the community do to prevent alcohol and other drug use?"
 2. **Make your pledge to be alcohol and drug free.** Go to the local event website at www.buzzfreepromisesdressgiveaway.org. Click on the "sign the pledge", read the pledge and then click "I Agree." Complete the registration form and be sure to record the username you've selected: _____. You'll receive an acknowledgement email plus the first of the many BUZZFREEBIES you'll receive for making the choice to have a smart and healthy substance-free prom night.
 3. **Return the completed Registration, release form (attached document) and essay paper** to your school or community representative or adult sponsor who recommended you no later than *Friday, February 19, 2010*. Keep one copy for your records and make sure to bring to the event. **"FIRST 100 YOUTH TO COMPLETE THE REGISTRATION PROCESS AND RETURN BY February 4TH, WILL BE ENTERED IN A DRAWING FOR A "FREE PROM NIGHT LIMO RIDE".**
 4. **Keep a copy of the Registered Participant Info sheet**; it has all of the event-day information you'll need.
 5. **You will receive an event participation confirmation** via email, text or postcard once the application is completed and received by event planners.

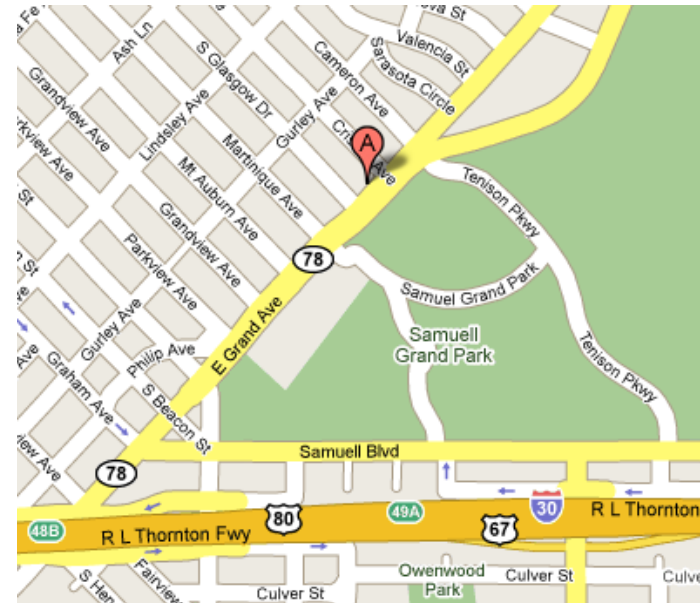
